Families and children learn language together through play, story time, and other activities. Themes are chosen based on everyday routines and experiences as requested by families. Outreach Early Intervention Specialists coordinate FLIP and invite experts who are highly qualified in spoken language, listening skill development, and American Sign Language. **FLIP** is for deaf and hard of hearing children ages birth to eight and their families/siblings/caretakers.
